PARENTAL CODE OF CONDUCT

Mission Statement

The Multicultural Community Family Services soccer program, Multicultural United Soccer Club (MUSC), exists to promote youth soccer and the sport of soccer in general. The goal of MUSC is to develop youths in body and build strong character through social skills, instruction and modeling. The precept of fair play, honesty, sportsmanship, teamwork, mutual respect and responsibility serves as the foundation for the MCFS soccer program.

MUSC is committed to increasing participation in and exposure to the game of soccer by providing a variety of organized soccer activities in a positive environment. MUSC is also committed to providing an optimal playing environment for recreational, developmental and competitive player participants of the Multicultural Community Family Services organization.

Requirements for Participation

1. **Equipment:**
 - Parent/Guardian provides cleats, shin guards, and athletic shorts. (Ask Scott Bryant if you need help with this.)
 - Player brings his/her own water to every practice or game.
2. **Transportation:**
 - Players must have transportation to and from practices and games. If special arrangements are necessary, it is the parent's responsibility to arrange alternate transportation. (A list of teammates with phone numbers will be provided to help in this area.)
3. **Attendance:**
 - Players are expected to be on time for all practices and games.
 - Parents need to attend the Parents Soccer Meeting orientation meeting this summer.
 - Parents are strongly encouraged to attend games and other functions.
4. **Finalizing Registration:** The following must be returned right away (or **no later than July 15th**):
 - Registration Form
 - \$75 registration fee (or approval for scholarship or payment plan from MUSC)
 - Copy of official proof of birth date of player
 - Signed Parent's Code of Conduct and Signed Player's Code of Conduct

Parent's Code of Conduct:

As a parent/guardian of a child who participates in the Multicultural United Soccer Club, I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care and encouragement for my child/ward's participation in MUSC by following the Parent's Code of Conduct.

- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches and officials at every game, practice or other youth soccer event.
- I will do my very best to make youth soccer fun for my child.
- I will not coach my child or other players during a game. If I do not agree with a coaching decision or a referee's decision, I will refrain from vocalizing my dissatisfaction in an effort to promote and reinforce the positive and enjoyable soccer experience envisioned by the MUSC mission statement.
- I will treat all other players, coaches, fans and officials with respect, good manners and common decency.
- I will tell my child to treat other players, coaches, fans and officials with respect, good manner and common decency.
- I will help my child's team by assisting the MCFS organization, coaches and manager as needed and helping with transportation rides as I am able to do so.
- I will make every effort to demonstrate support for my child by attending his/her soccer games.

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MULTICULTURAL COMMUNITY FAMILY SERVICES PLAYER'S CODE OF CONDUCT

As a Multicultural United Soccer Club player, I hereby pledge to provide a positive attitude and be responsible for my participation in the youth soccer program by following the Player's Code of Conduct.

- I will accept as a pre-requisite to being a member of the soccer program that I will regularly attend and participate in the MUSC character-building soccer support group.
- I will attend every practice and game that is reasonably possible for me to attend and will notify my coach if I cannot attend.
- I will arrive at every PRACTICE and GAME ON TIME as required by my coaches.
- I will accept seriously the responsibility and privilege of representing our community, my family, my soccer club, and the Multicultural Community Family Services organization.
- I will do my best to listen and learn from my coaches and team manager.
- I will treat my coaches, team manager, fellow soccer players, fans and officials with respect, good manners and common decency at all times.
- I will refrain from the use of any "curse" words at all times during practices and games.
- I will do my best to treat others as I wish to be treated by others.
- I will expect to receive a fair and equal amount of playing time during practices.
- I realize that I may not receive an equal amount of playing time during games and pledge not to complain to my coach about this.
- I will accept that my coaches have the best interest of the team in mind and will not criticize decisions that my coaches and team manager make during practices or games.
- I will talk to my coaches privately if I do not like a decision that was made during a practice or game.
- I will do my very best in school and maintain good grades.
- I will demonstrate respect for my teachers, school administrators and other students while in school.
- I will remember that youth soccer is an opportunity for me to learn and have fun.
- I will encourage my parent(s)/guardian(s) to be involved with my team and the Multicultural Community Family Services organization in some capacity because it is important to me, the organization and our community.
- I will obey the rules of the sport of soccer and the MUSC player's code of conduct, and will be barred from the MCFS soccer program if I do not comply.
